What to Know Before You Go Cruising with National REIA:

What does the price include?

Register Early For Bigger Discounts

The price of the cruise based upon date of registration includes 7 Night **Cruise** sailing from Galveston, TX on February 6th and returning to Galveston on February 13th, Pre Paid Gratuities, Pre Paid Port Charges, Pre Paid Taxes, Three days of seminars, Evening Q & A Sessions, All Meals and Food

What is not included in the price?

You are individually responsible for soda pop, beer, wine and alcohol. The ship provides at no charge water, juice and tea.

Also, airfare and airport transfers are **NOT** included in the base price of the cruise. There is a charge of \$35 per person available only through National REIA from Houston Hobby Airport to the Port of Galveston where you will board the Voyager of the Seas on February 6, 2010 between the hours on 12 PM and 3 PM.

What Airport Should I fly into?

There are two airports in the Houston Area, it is suggested that you fly into **Houston Hobby Airport**. It is the closest airport to the Port of Galveston. **Houston Hobby Airport** is roughly 30 minutes to the Port of Galveston.

When should I arrange to leave and/or depart from the cruise?

Schedule flights to arrive no later than 12pm CST into Houston Hobby on February 6, 2011, and plan your departure after 12pm CST from Houston Hobby on February 13, 2011. If you are in an area prone to winter weather conditions it is strongly suggested to fly in a day early to avoid delays or missed connections.

Once I register for the Cruise, when will I receive my cruise tickets?

Tickets, credentials and your cruise attendee booklet (which includes the week's schedule, speaker bios and topics) will be mailed TWO weeks prior to sailing. Because these will be shipped express we CAN NOT accept a P.O. Box due to the time sensitiveness nature of the mailing.

Do I need a passport?

YES! You must have a valid passport from your country of origin in order to board the cruise ship. If you not have a passport you will not be permitted to board.

What if I do not have a roommate?

National REIA will try its best to connect you with a roommate. This will be based upon availability, but generally Royal Caribbean will request that you pay for a single occupancy cabin. The charge of single occupancy generally runs 150% of the standard rate but please contact troy@nationalreia.com to check for availability in our inventory.

What if I am a single and know of another single cruiser that I would like to room with?

Please submit this request with your registration either online or hard copy registration. We will follow up with that individual to confirm your request, and do our best to fulfill the request.

What if I am being joined on the cruise by someone who is not participating in the conference?

What pricing is available for children?

Royal Caribbean considered anyone who is onboard the ship with a "beating heart" to be a paid passenger. If this child is the second cruiser in a cabin they must pay full price of either a participating or non-participating cruiser.

If the child is the third or fourth passenger, they will receive a discounted rate of \$497 only if they are a non-participating cruiser. If they are third or fourth passenger of a cabin and wish to be considered a participating cruiser there will be an event fee of \$399 per person or \$600 for two people.

**please note that triple or quad cabins are limited and available on a first come basis*

What if we want a triple or quad cabin?

If the attendee is the third or fourth passenger, they will receive a discounted rate of \$497 only if they are a non-participating cruiser. If they are third or fourth passenger of a cabin and wish to be considered a participating cruiser there will be an event fee of \$399 per person or \$600 for two people.

**please note that triple or quad cabins are limited and available on a first come basis*

Can I set up a payment plan or pay in installments?

National REIA has secured the rate available by securing a block of cabins, and as we get closer to sail date we must release un-booked cabins back to Royal Caribbean's Inventory. This means to secure any attendees space, all registrations must be paid in full at the time of registration.

Can I book my cruise outside of National REIA?

Royal Caribbean has allowed National REIA meeting space based upon the cabins we have reserved for the Voyager of the Seas February 6, 2010 Sailing. Based on the cabins we are allotted, we are given meeting space on the ship to accommodate those passengers. If we fall below those numbers we then in return lose meeting space, and cannot offer space to those cruising outside of our cabin block.

Is it possible to cancel with a refund in the event I cannot attend?

A full refund is available until December 1, 2010. After December 1, 2010 you will be charged \$300 per person. Cancellation after January 1, 2011 will receive a 50% refund. No refund is available after February 1, 2011 unless you have purchased the insurance protection policy.

Should I purchase Travel Insurance?

Travel Insurance is simply just that, Insurance. It is at your discretion to purchase insurance made available for \$129 per person. If you would like a copy of the policy please contact troy@nationalreia.com for full details of what the insurance covers.

If I wait to register closer to sailing, will there still be space for me?

For the past five years, our sailing has **SOLD OUT**. Not just National REIA's Cabin Block, but the sailings we arrange are in high cruising season. Many, like you, are those hoping to escape the winter weather, and those hoping to celebrate the Valentine's Day Season. Cabins are on a first come first serve basis, and we cannot hold space unless you are paid in full.
